






The D95 Tile System is Fabbian's Premier Crystal offering for completely customizable design concepts.

Crystal is created by infusing lead into glass at high pressure.

Though a chemical bonding process, the lead clarifies the glass to make it entirely clear, resembling a diamond.





## D95 Tile - A Unique Design Platform

Similar to a diamond, light passed over crystal will catch on every edge or facet of the molded or cut pattern.

Each 12" x 4.6" section of Tile contains 12 facets in asymmetric triangular patterns to redirect light throughout the entire final sculpture system.
